Laminated shades

They are hard backed shades with the fabric laminated onto styrene or parchment .
This gives a clean-lined contemporary look and helps the lampshade to keep its shape over the years.
Designed and engineered for lampshade manufacturing, these sturdy and durable materials have many treatments including anti-yellowing, anti-static, UV stabilisation and fire resistance .

Pictured below are some common shapes we manufacture . The shade will be adjusted in size to fit your lamp : Table or Floor lamp, Wall-light or ceiling pendant.

Traditional shades

The fabric is stretched, pleated or gathered around a metal frame then hand-stitched and trimmed at the top and bottom . We mostly use natural fabrics such as silk (Pongee, Dupion, Taffetas) linen or satin cotton .

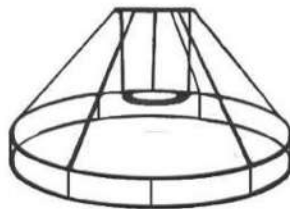
We usually put two layers of fabric : a cover and a thin lining to moderate the light.

With these techniques, we can create intricate constructions and interesting shadows that help to give an elaborate effect that will suit an antique base.

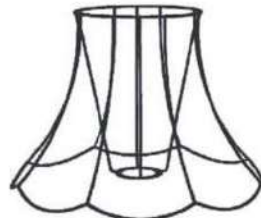
Shown below are the most common shapes . The shade will be adjusted in size to fit your lamp : Table or Floor lamp, Wall-light or ceiling pendant.

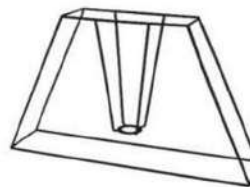

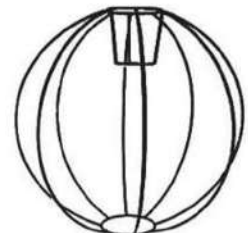

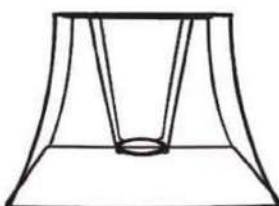

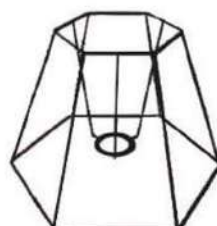
